About the organisation:

Cambodian Youth Action (CYA) founded in October 10, 2010 as a non - governmental and not for profit organization aims providing opportunity for youth to explore themselves and the world through Interntional Voluntary Service. CYA legally registered with Ministry of Interior of Royal government of Cambodia on November 11, 2014.

CYA is a full member of Network for Voluntary development in Asia (NVDA) since 2012 and Coordinating Committee for Interntional Voluntary Service (CCIVS) since 2014. CYA is also a partner of Service Civil Interntional (SCI) and ALLIANCE of European Voluntary Service.


CYA mission is to provide the IVS, International Voluntary Service opportunity for youth between 16 - 35 years old to explore themselves and the world and become active global citizens.

CYA Vision is to be the trusted and reliable International Voluntary Service organization in Cambodia offering best IVS program for youth from around the world to get inspire, engage, and to be empowered to take action toward world peace and sustainability.

CYA believes that through cooperating with local and international partners in organizing international voluntary service programs, CYA brings youth from around the world to meet, share, discuss, and learn from each other in order to create their better future while helping to support development of local community where children and teenagers will have more opprtunities to see the world outside of their place.

Location:

Headquarter of CYA is in Phnom Penh, the capital of Cambodia. CYA has several workcamps in different areas of Cambodia, volunteers will travel according to the workcamp activities they are joining.



Logistics, food and accommodation:

- Volunteers will work maximum *35 hours* per week.
- Volunteers will have *2 consecutive days off* per week.
- Volunteers have *2 days of vacation* per month. Those days can be cumulated during the months.
- Food will be provided by the organisation. Please be aware of the typical cuisine and food traditions of the country, it can be hard to find western food, adaptability and will to discover new food habits is an important mind-set.
- Volunteers will join different workcamps during their stay, and accommodation situation may change according to the place. Mainly, volunteers will be in shared rooms with other volunteers and will share the bathroom. In general, do not expect western “standards” for the accommodation and the toilet. Usually Cambodian toilets are squat toilets, with manual flushing (bucket with water). Again, it is required adaptability, volunteers should adapt to the living conditions of the locals, and it is not possible to provide special treatments.
- Aside food and accommodation, volunteers will receive a *monthly pocket money*: 90 € that can be used for any personal expense.
- Transfers related to the projects will be covered by the organisation. For personal travels, costs are on the volunteers.



Activities:



- Workcamp with both local and international volunteers (Visit the community and live with local people to learn and experience about local living condition, lifestyle, culture while getting to know more about local needs, and generating new ideas for solution. - Work with local people to improve hygiene and sanitation and the living environment. - Teach English, sports, music, arts, and computer to students)
- Organise intercultural events
- Organise a Youth Exchange with Asian partner organisations
- Cooperation with local volunteers
- Production of articles or videos about the volunteering experience
- Promotion of the organisation's activities
